

Directions to the LSU Energy, Coast & Environment Building from Interstate 10

- Exit I-10 at Acadian Thruway (Exit 157B). If exiting from the eastbound off-ramp you will take a right onto Acadian Thruway; if exiting from the westbound off-ramp you will take a left onto Acadian Thruway.
- Take Acadian Thruway (which becomes “Stanford Avenue” and “LSU Avenue”) to Highland Rd. and turn right.
- On Highland, after crossing West Parker Boulevard, continue straight on into campus (through South Gates). The road will immediately fork—bear left onto Nicholson Drive Extension.
- The Energy, Coast & Environment Building is about ¼ mile down on right, just past the Campus Federal Credit Union. See photo of building below.
- Reserved parking spaces are located in the lot to the west (left) of the rotunda.
